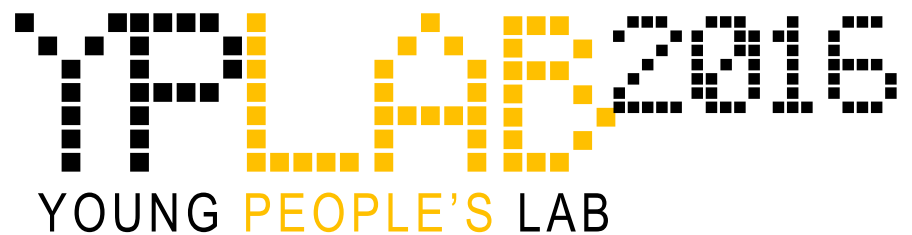

1.0 INTRODUCTION

The Young People's Lab (YPLAB2016) is a day workshop, initiated as a peripheral event of the 8th series of the 'International Conference on World Class Sustainable Cities' (WCSC) event, focusing on young professionals (under 40 years of age) from the built environment spectrum.

This year's WCSC is themed 'City Spaces, Public Places' with the objectives of addressing and focusing on the benefits of greater accessibility and better public spaces that will enhance social, economic and environmental elements of the city and its livability. Urban public spaces – sidewalks, parks, squares, traditional markets, and small plazas — and how people use them – humanize cities. In the pursuit for a World Class City, the basic necessities of its citizens may be compromised due to the ever-increasing population size and spatial area, as well as economic growth.

In tandem with WCSC's 'City Spaces, Public Spaces' theme, YPLAB2016 has adopted 'Placemaking by Youth: Connecting the Urban Dots' as its theme.

YPLAB2016 engages youths to bring their collective energy, creativity and vision to the table to analyse, discuss and generate ideas and solutions to selected urban enclaves.

2.0 ORGANISER

YPLAB2016 is co-organised by the Youth Committees of Pertubuhan Aritek Malaysia (PAM), Malaysian Institute of Planners (MIP), Institute of Engineers Malaysia (IEM), Real Estate & Housing Developers' Association (REHDA) and supported by Kuala Lumpur City Hall (DBKL).

PAM is the Organising Chair for this cycle, which is held in rotation by the collaborating institutes. MIP chaired the inaugural YPLAB in 2015. The LAB was attended by over 130 young architects, planners, engineers and developers.

3.0 AIM OF YPLAB2016

YPLAB2016 aims to be a platform for the young people to express their creative ideas and thoughts in achieving a livable and sustainable built environment.

YPLAB2016 is part of a broader initiative in reaching out to the young people - giving them opportunity and hope for a better future. The participants will be analyzing, discussing and submitting ideas on the role of youth in regenerating the urban fabric and the outcomes will be presented by the winning team/youth representative in the 8th WCSC Conference 2016.

4.0 OBJECTIVES OF YPLAB2016

The objectives of YPLAB2016 are:

- i. Knowledge-sharing and engaging ideas from young people from the built environment industry
- ii. Sharing practical experiences and empowering ideas; and
- iii. Creating good networking among young professionals.
